Upcoming Inclement Weather Conditions

Due to expected inclement weather and road conditions early next week, Texas A&M University nonessential employees located in Bryan and College Station have been instructed to work remotely (if possible) on Monday, Feb. 15 and Tuesday, Feb. 16. Employees may be granted emergency leave if the unsafe travel conditions expected on Monday and Tuesday prevent them from reporting to work when the University has not officially closed. Individuals who cannot work remotely as a direct result of the weather conditions should discuss the circumstances with their supervisor and request emergency leave if appropriate. Department heads may request emergency leave on behalf of an affected employee or a group of affected employees. Employees can request to use annual leave, compensatory time or sick leave as applicable, if they are requesting the day off from remote work for personal reasons or illness.
