## Long-Term Care Insurance Virtual Information Sessions, April 1 through May 18

Long-Term Care insurance is available through ACSIA Partners under the [PerksConnect](#) voluntary benefits platform. As part of this offering, a special enrollment window is available April 1 through June 1, 2021 to all eligible Texas A&M employees and their eligible spouses. Advantages of enrolling now include unisex rates and portable coverage (coverage will continue even if you move or change jobs). Employees hired after May 4, 2020 can also enroll with a simplified health screening (reduced health questions) which will not be available after June 1, 2021. This coverage is not paid through payroll deduction, but through payment options directly with the vendor.

ACSIA Partners, one of the largest long-term care specialists, will host eight virtual information sessions starting April 1 through May 18 to discuss this valuable voluntary benefit and answer questions.
