**Vaccine: No cost to you - Vaccination will be covered under insurance.** For your convenience and to promote good health, Human Resources is partnering with Texas A&M Health Science Center, College of Nursing, College of Pharmacy, and Texas A&M Physicians to offer flu vaccine (quadrivalent injection) clinics for any Texas A&M System employee their family members. Limited doses of the pediatric vaccine for children under age 3 or the high-dose vaccine for individuals age 65 or older. **The nasal mist option is not available per [CDC recommendations](#).**

**Parking:** You may carpool; GSC Lot 88 is open to any campus hangtag. Visitors without a valid parking hangtag may use the paid visitor parking. If choosing to utilize 30 minute parking, please ensure you are watching your time and don't exceed the 30 minute duration and avoid peak times if possible. Or take bus route #6 (12th Man).

Parents wishing to have the vaccine reported in their child's ImmTrac record should complete the C-7 Immunization Registry Consent Form available on the Department of State Health Services [website](#) and bring to the clinic. Vaccinations will not automatically be reported.

1. Print, complete, and bring with you, the **required form**.  
(*One form needed for each individual getting vaccinated.*)

2. Bring photocopies of your picture ID and insurance card
3. Bring your picture ID card.
4. Bring your insurance ID card.\* (Cash payment will not be available)
5. Wear appropriate clothing.

*\*Those using an insurance outside a Texas A&M System plan should verify coverage with their insurance carrier prior to attending the clinic and confirm Texas A&M Physicians is in network.*
